NOTE: Statements of more than one hundred (100) words, as per instructions, will disqualify this application.

Counting of words, for purposes of this application, shall be as follows:

- 1. Punctuation is not counted.
- 2. Each word shall be counted as one word except as specified below:
 - a. All geographical names shall be considered as one word. (Example- "City and County of Los Angeles" shall be counted as one word)
 - b. Each abbreviation for a word, phrase, or expression shall be counted as one word.
 - c. Hyphenated words that appear in any generally available dictionary shall be considered as one word. Each part of all other hyphenated words shall be counted as a separate word.
 - d. Dates consisting of a combination of words and digits shall be counted as two words. Dates consisting of only a combination of digits shall be counted as one word.
 - e. Any number consisting of a digit or digits shall be considered as one word. Any number which is spelled, such as "one" shall be considered as a separate word or words. "One" shall be counted as one word whereas "one hundred" shall be counted as two words. "100" shall be counted as one word.
