## ***The Who, What, When, Where and How of the 2021 Needs Assessment Survey***

The Safe, Clean Neighborhood Park, Open Space, Beaches, River Protection and Water Conservation Measure of 2016, otherwise known as Ballot Measure A was passed with overwhelming Los Angeles County taxpayer support (74.9%). The passage of Measure A has opened a door for our community to both improve and enhance local recreational needs.

The intent of Ballot Measure A was, and is, to continue the local park funding which began in 1992 with the passage of Proposition A (Prop A) and the subsequent formation of the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District (RPOSD). As many of you already know Prop A was the main source of the funding that created Acton Park.

As opposed to the finite revenue of Prop A, the annual revenue generated by the passage of Measure A is perpetual. The criteria for solicitation of funds is outlined in Measure A's Grant Administration Manual (GAM) which you may review in detail at <https://rposd.lacounty.gov>

Recently, our community was given an opportunity by Supervisor Kathryn Barger to update the Needs Assessment of our area in order to more accurately represent the views of our community as it may apply to available funding opportunities. To this end, Friends of Acton Park along with the Acton Town Council are conducting a survey to enable the RPOSD to identify our community concerns and desires for Acton Park as well as alternative local recreational needs that may fall under the funding provisions outlined in GAM.

On the attached survey please take a look at some of the ideas that have been previously submitted through Friends of Acton Park or the Acton Town Council. Some listed are in keeping with specific Measure A objectives while others are expressions of community desire for alternative improvements. We have also added some blank spaces for additional ideas to be included by you.
