

**Note\*** A lot of concern has been expressed recently about loss of significant summertime day use of Acton Park due to rising temperatures and the need to create more shade to adapt. The following are suggestions that have been made to address this issue.

- Shade Structure for existing exercise equipment on north side of Acton Park.
- Picnic Table Shade Structures in addition to trees at Acton Park.
- More Shade Trees throughout Acton Park.
- More Shade Trees along walking path at Acton Park.

**Note\*** The undeveloped 3 acres at the far west side of Acton Park is a significant floodway and cannot be developed in any way that obstructs the natural water runoff during storms but could include the following.

- Dog Park** - Enclosed non-grass off-leash dog area in undeveloped west end of Acton Park (within designated floodway) .
- Multi-purpose Trailhead** - Southwest corner of undeveloped property at Acton Park connecting to dedicated trail system (within designated floodway).
- Extension of Walking Path** through undeveloped property at Acton Park to include flora and fauna educational aspect (within designated floodway).
