

## Notes on CSD

The work on the CSD (Community Standards District) has been ongoing since 2018. After two community meetings the CSD Committee came up with the original proposal topics or items to ask for in the Acton CSD. After countless meetings with the County, the CSD is going for final approval at the Board of Supervisors on July 27, 2021. The committee has many items that have not been taken care of to our satisfaction. We need community members to reach out to our Supervisor, Kathryn Barger and express your feelings about the CSD. Acton needs to flood her with letters about how we feel and hopefully get her attention that our community needs have not yet been taken care of.

The attached Acton CSD Summary separately lists the items that the committee and community asked for but did not get, the items that were removed from the CSD by the County that we wanted to keep, the items added to the CSD by the County that we did not ask for or want, and the items we asked for and received. There are many items that the committee feels are important to the well being of our community and we have fought to have them in the CSD. Most of these items come from the "Removed from CSD and want to keep", and "Did not ask for but added to the CSD". Everything we "Asked for but did not get" are items that the committee has had many conversations with the County. The committee was given various reasons for the items that were not added to the CSD. They included the item is already in Title 22, or another County agency has jurisdiction. The committee feels that many of these items belong in the CSD in order to make it easier for the community. Such as animal keeping should be referred to where it can be found in Title 22. This would make it easier for current residents and future residents or business owners to navigate the CSD.
