Overview of Current Local Recreation Facilities

Acton Park consists of approximately 12.5 acres (9+ developed acres and approximately 3 undeveloped acres in a significant floodway at the west end of property). Current amenities include: a basketball court, a restroom building, 2 softball fields, 2 soccer fields areas, numerous picnic tables and BBQs scattered throughout the southern 1/3 of the developed portion of the park, numerous benches for seating along pathways, 1/2 mile perimeter walking path, 2 children's playground equipment areas, a covered group picnic area and a pavilion.

Two other well established community recreation facilities in Acton are the ballfields operated by Sierra Youth Sports on LA County owned property in the riverbed area and the privately owned and operated Acton Community Club which has an equestrian arena and a multi-purpose building.

- Splash Pad
- BMX Track
- 4H Facility
