3. Had known contact with a COVID-19 positive individual or are waiting for the results of a COVID-19 test.



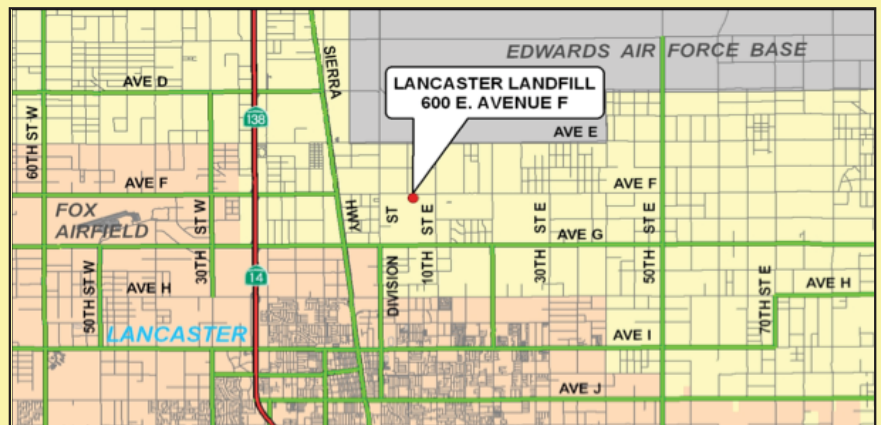
