INTENDED PARTICIPANTS: Local elected officials, County's offices for planning, emergency services, public health and or other mission-related departments or divisions, and other interested parties.

CONTEXT: In 2021, <u>Senate Bill 552 (SB 552)</u> was signed by Governor Newsom and enacted into law. SB 552 includes new responsibilities and requirements at both the state and local levels to help small water systems and rural communities reduce their risk of water shortage during droughts or other emergencies. DWR, in collaboration with the State Water Board, other State agencies, counties, and interested parties, voluntarily prepared a guidebook for counties on preparation of a County Drought Resilience Plan as part of supporting the local implementation of SB 552.

WEBINAR PURPOSE: DWR will provide financial and direct technical assistance to counties for developing their County Drought Resilience Plan per SB 552 to provide needed water shortage protection and emergency response for state small water systems and domestic wells. This Webinar will mark the launch and availability of these assistance opportunities.
